Worship in Matthew's Gospel

³²“When they climbed back into the boat, the wind stopped. ³³Then the disciples worshiped him. “You really are the Son of God!” They exclaimed.” Matthew 14:32-33 NLT

Have you ever had an “Aha!” moment with the Lord? All of a sudden, His greatness, mercy, provision, faithfulness, and love are revealed to your heart and mind in a “Wow, God, You are truly awesome!” moment. Jesus' disciples experienced this while in a boat in the middle of the night. Jesus had been away from his disciples, praying, and he had told his disciples to cross the lake in a boat. Now, in the darkness of night, they are battling a storm and fighting heavy waves. Jesus came to them walking on the water, and Peter asks if he can walk on the water out to Jesus. You know the story – Peter allows his focus to move from Jesus to the waves around him and he begins to sink. He cries out for Jesus to save him, and Jesus pulls him back up, challenging Peter to question the strength of his faith. As they climb back into the boat, the waves stop, and the disciples have witnessed these two miracles – walking on the stormy water and Jesus calming the waves around them. They have an “Aha” moment, praising Jesus saying, “You really are the Son of God!” When you've had a moment like this – God revealing Himself and His power – has it caused you to stop in a moment of worship? Lord, let it be so.

Isaiah 61:1-2

“The Spirit of the Lord God is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and freedom to the prisoners; to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor, and the day of our God's vengeance; to comfort all who mourn.”

You can almost feel Isaiah's excitement when he wrote this passage. He was excited by his call from God and excited to go to the sick and poor and bring hope. Why don't we as Christians share in that hope and excitement? Why do we not have an excitement to serve those without and give plentifully?
