Worship in Matthew's Gospel

"But you would not have condemned my innocent disciples if you knew the meaning of this Scripture, "I want you to show mercy, not offer sacrifices." For the Son of Man is Lord, even over the Sabbath!" Matthew 12:7-8 NLT

In this passage of Matthew, Jesus has already done much teaching and healing in many locations throughout the land. And here, He is being chastised for His disciples picking grain to eat on the Sabbath. Jesus, first reminds the accusers of when David and his companions ate the show-bread in the temple and that the priests are allowed to work on the Sabbath, both actions forbidden in the Law. But God deemed it allowable in these examples, and Jesus, referring to Himself as the Lord over the Sabbath, has deemed His disciple's actions allowable in this situation.

But the interesting part, to me, in this passage of Matthew is that Jesus reprimands these men for not understanding the true meaning of Hosea 6:6:

"I want you to show mercy, not offer sacrifices." Through His prophet Hosea, God is emphasizing the importance of our heart and intentions in worship over the process and rituals by which we express that worship. Remember that "people judge by outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart." (1 Samuel 16:7)
