Purpose Statement: To help students grow in Worship, Discipleship, and Mission.

1. Qualifications and Position Requirements:

- Exhibit a personal and growing relationship with God, a teachable spirit, and a healthy family life.
- Committed to God and the Student Ministry. Regularly attends church services and events. Participates in worship and committed to tithing.
- Committed to pray regularly for the Student Ministry and leaders.
- Gifted and called to work with students, loves young people, and has a passion for evangelism and outreach, both personally and on a ministry level.
- Engaging teacher, with strong biblical and theological background, who holds to PBC's statement of beliefs.
- Self-motivated leader, capable of casting and imparting vision for ministry, possessing relational skills with students, parents, and staff.
- Committed to personal spiritual disciplines such as prayer, Bible study, evangelism, personal worship, Scripture memory and accountability.

2. Characteristic Duties and Responsibilities:

- Lead and organize effective youth programs implementing fellowship, worship, discipleship, evangelism and mission.
- Recruit, train and utilize a volunteer staff with diverse gifts and personalities for the work of Student Ministry.
- Provide counseling and spiritual direction to students on an individual basis.
- Maintain contact with families, keeping them informed of ongoing activities. Keep parents updated on ministry strategies and plans in a way that encourages partnership and involvement.
- Support parents in effectively fulfilling their Christian parenting roles, in concert with PBC staff.
- Assist in the development and oversight of the youth ministry budget and manage student fees for events and trips in a timely fashion.
- Seek to integrate students into all phases of church life to grow a culture of intentional intergenerational unity and complement.
- Actively look for ways to make meetings and events run smoother.
- Follow through on responsibilities.
- Find areas in the Student Ministry and offer suggestions for improvement.
- Work to get students more involved in church through events and activities.

3. Expectations:

- Arrive 30 minutes prior to the beginning of any scheduled event to ensure the necessary support staff and items are in place.

- Mingle with students from any school and make newcomers feel welcome to the Student Ministry.
- Model sexual purity and integrity in your relationships. This includes modesty in dress and speech. Be an example of Christ in your dating or married life.
- In the event of absence for whatever reason contact staff and key leaders to ensure all responsibilities under your care are fulfilled.
- Attend staff trainings and meetings.
- Diffuse gossip, rumors and conflict.
- Stay a positive example in all you do.
